
from the tank

in the jungle. That is exactly what was done, over three miles of one and one-half inch (1 ½") pipe from the catch basin













to a new concrete tank they had to build.

running to the land for the shelter.

The land is cleared, settled with all the rain and ready to build on.

Another tank will be installed above the new building site so that the pressure will always be good and to provide water in case of emergencies. The tank will be just about where Chom-nom and I are standing in the picture with the running water above.

This system can also provide water to some of the village below the new children's shelter.
